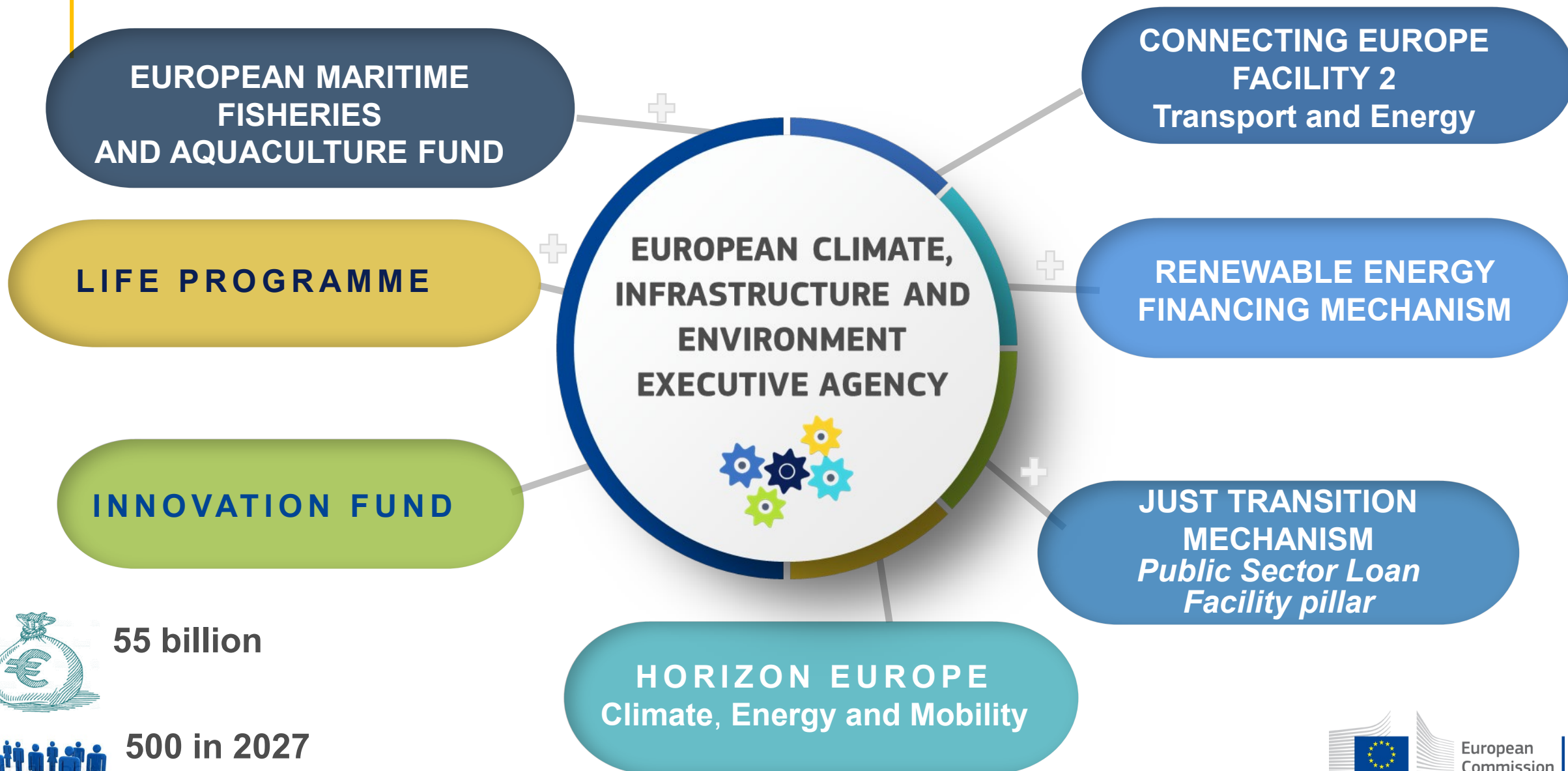

CEF Energy 2021- 2027

- Overall budget: **€5.84** billion for:

- **Projects of Common Interest (PCIs)**

- CEF 2021 call for proposals concluded; funding allocated to 5 actions - €1.037 billion
- CEF 2022 call for proposals: under evaluation

- **Cross-border projects in the field of renewable energy:**

- 2021 CEF call for prep study: 2 actions selected
- 2022 CEF call for prep studies: currently open

OBJECTIVES:

- ✔ Contribute to **joint planning, development and cost effective** exploitation of renewables
- ✔ Facilitate **the integration of renewables** through energy storage and conversion facilities
- ✔ Contribute to **strategic uptake of innovative** renewable energy technologies
- ✔ Promote **cooperation** between Member States and 3rd countries
- ✔ Contribute to the goals of the **EU Green Deal**, as well as the **Paris Agreement**
- ✔ Contribute to the **2030 climate and energy targets and long-term decarbonisation objectives**

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Call for Preparatory Studies EUR 1 million available Application period: from 20 Sept 2022 to 10 Jan 2023	Calls for the CB RES status Next call expected at the beginning of 2023	Call for Works & Studies EUR 30 million available Application period: from 8 Nov 2022 to 23 Feb 2023
To support EU Member States and project promoters in selecting the best project concept and setting up the cooperation agreement. The call allows for projects to be supported before applying for the CB RES status.	Having the CB RES status is a requirement to be eligible for CEF grants, and it could provide further benefits such as higher visibility, increased investor certainty, and stronger political support from Member States.	To support project promoters to carry out and implement works and studies. Works can include development, construction and installation activities. Studies can include mapping, feasibility, evaluation, testing and validation studies.
No requirement is needed to apply, other than what is indicated in the call.	Note that applying to this call is mandatory to be able to apply for the Works & Studies call.	Only projects with CB RES status can apply.
